Secretary's Report:

Newsletter E-mailing:

Over half of the e-mails for the newsletter bounced. Gary made an executive decision. The newsletter will no longer be sent via e-mail. The re-mailer will be used to send notices when the newsletter is available for download from the WAR web site. The newsletter notice can

Frequency Coordinator:

Dave has submitted WAR's data to the ARRL for the 2004 Repeater Directory. Dave has not received any feedback on the state of the submission.

Milt has caught up with coordination requests and Dave is caught up with cross coordinations between the other states. Michigan has fallen silent again. We have not received any communications from them in recent months.

IRLP:

Gary has only received two opinions in favor of listing this data in the WAR database. Correspondence has been received from all but three of the neighboring states. They indicate this is not part of frequency coordination. None of the states around us are tracking IRLP/Echolink information. This is an internet related feature and the most current information is maintained on the web. Therefore, WAR will not maintain IRLP/Echolink repeaters in the database.
