Coordination Secretary's Report

- Coordination Activity since March meeting...
 - 2 new coordinations issued
 - 6 operating modifications to existing coordinations
 - 46 responses to adjacent state NOPC's
 - 17 current open coordinations (in various states)
 - Limited options for 2m repeater pairs in certain parts of the state
 - Some are waiting on NOPC's from adjacent states
 - 21 coordinations in construction status
 - Planning to start reaching out in the next few weeks
- Annual Updates
 - We were still working to finish these up
 - Some outstanding ones that have not responded; now over a year old
 - We've reached out via mail, email and over the phone
- Modeling Tools
 - Working w/ IL on new modeling tool to identify new requirements for close-spaced coordinations
 - Currently use Radio Mobile, but looking to potentially transition to Signal Server
- Corey has been filling the role of Coordination Secretary & Frequency Coordinator
 - Working to build the Coordination Secretary Committee to help
 - Have several individuals interested

- Coordination of ARDEN Networks
 - Hasn't currently been any requests
 - If folks are interested we can definitely discuss
- Recommended Hotspot Frequencies John N9UPC
 - Looking to be proactive in setting up hotspot frequencies
 - Worried we're going to start crowding ourselves with all the new digital technologies
 - There have already been cases of unintentional interference both nationally and in the state
 - Tony KT9AC did do a lot of work on the band plan and did recommend some frequencies for hotspots
- Band Plan Wayne K9WKJ
 - ARDEN no mention of 2.4GHz spectrum?; What channels?; We can go quite a long ways with this
 - Hotspot frequencies not all radios can go that low to use the 420-432Mhz range
- Reach out with ideas/questions/concerns Rick W9RIX
 - Don't just wait till these meetings
 - Reach out to any member of the board with anything at anytime
- Indiana Repeater Council Jay K5ZC
 - Working on an online replacement for CTK
 - Includes ability for repeater owners to view their coordinations
 - Hoping to have a demo at next adjacent states meeting
